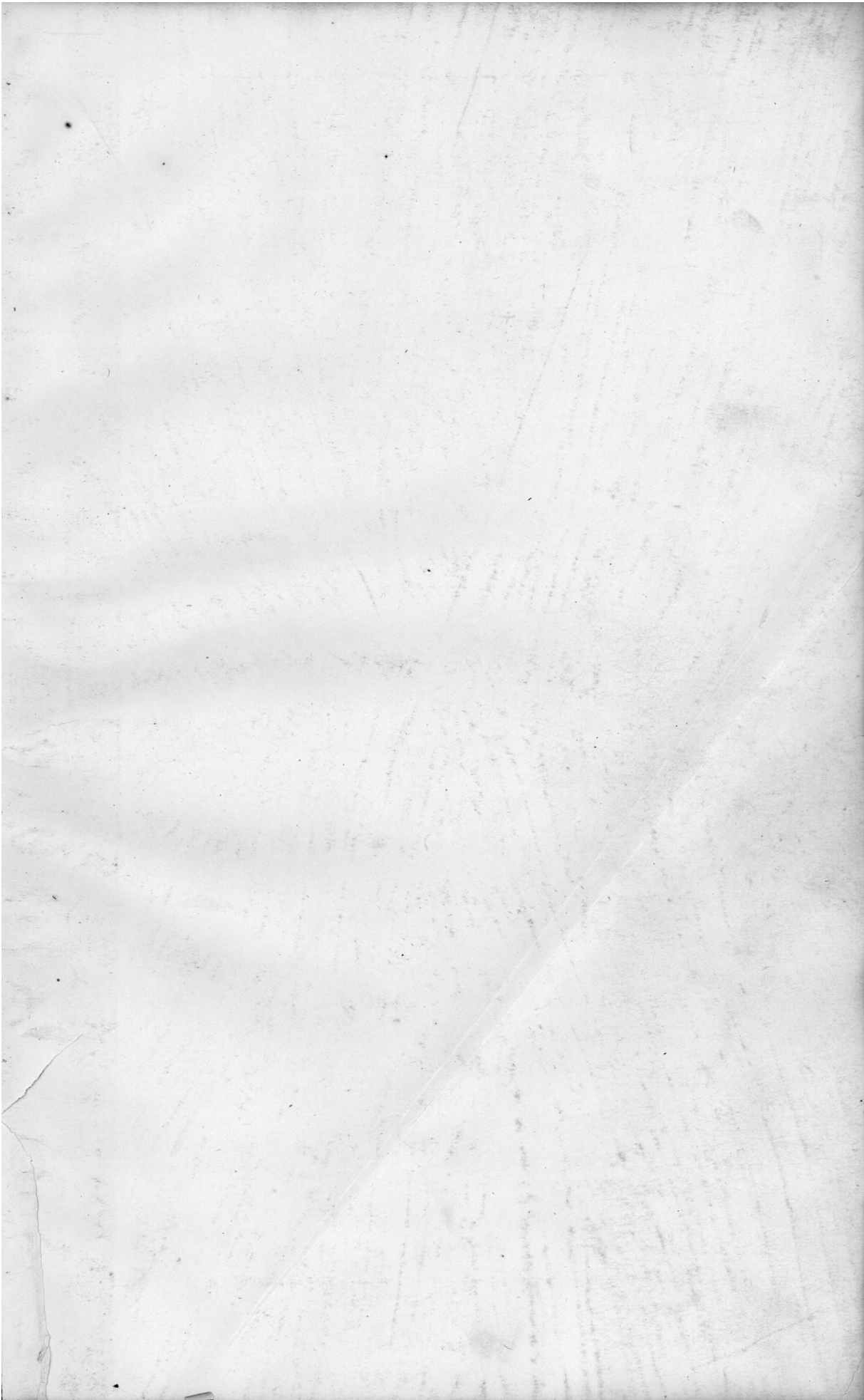




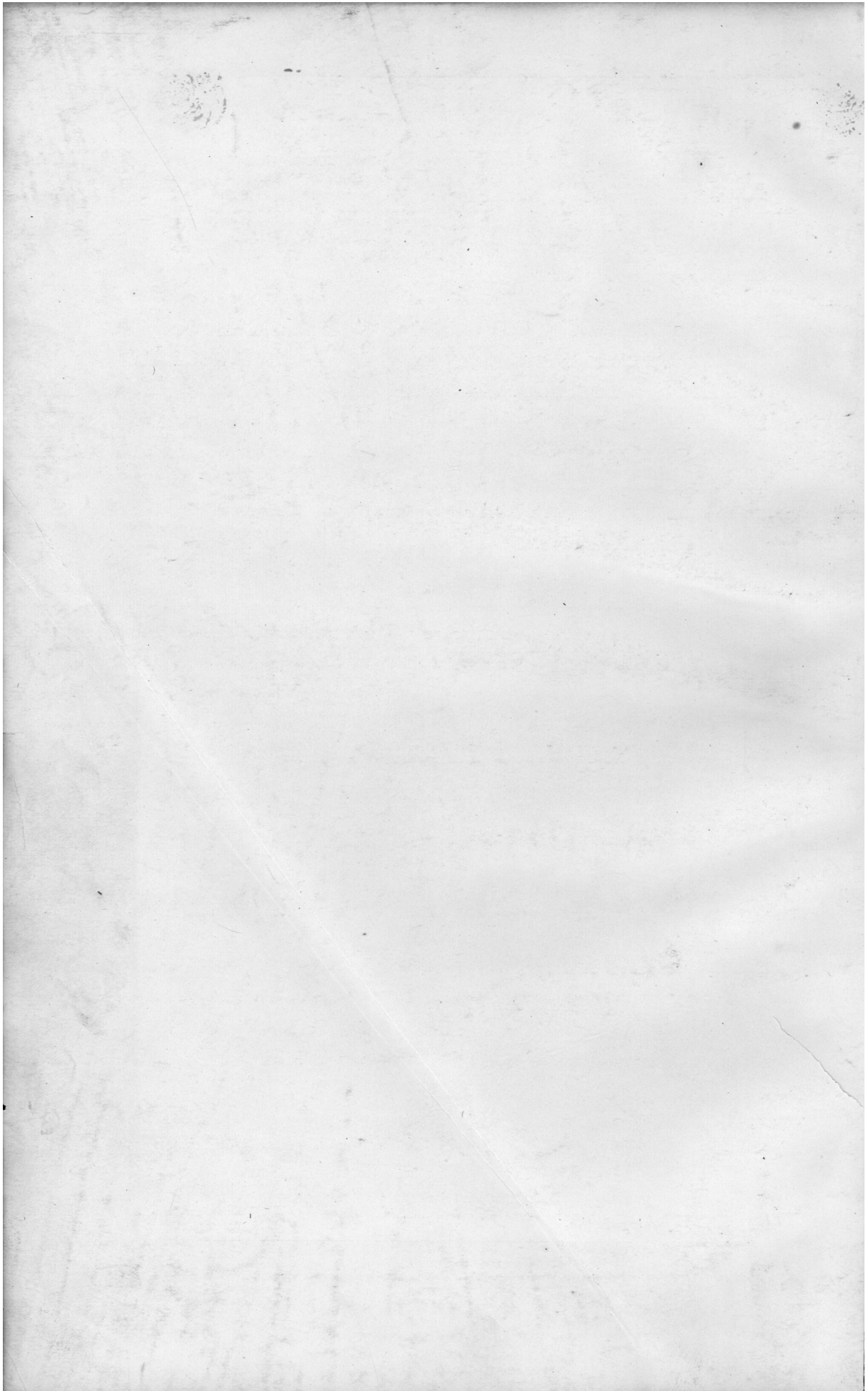












New Bonds, 25,000, issued  
July 1<sup>st</sup> 1891, by the Board of  
Fire & Water Commissioners of the  
City of Marquette, being Fifty  
Bonds of Five Hundred Dollars  
(\$500) each, bearing five per cent  
interest commencing July 1<sup>st</sup> 1891,  
ending July 1<sup>st</sup> 1901, payable at  
First National Bank Marquette  
Michigan and payable semiannually

New Bonds \$35,000. issued  
January 1<sup>st</sup> 1891. by the Board  
of Fire & Water Commissioners of the  
City of Marquette, being Seventy  
Thousands Bonds of Five hundred  
Dollars (\$500) each, bearing five  
per cent interest commencing January  
1<sup>st</sup> 1891. ending January 1<sup>st</sup> 1901.  
Number one to seventy inclusive.  
These bonds issued for the  
purpose of taking up matured  
Bonds issued January 1<sup>st</sup> 1881,  
which matured January 1<sup>st</sup> 1891, of like  
amount.

New Bonds (\$11,000)  
issued January 1<sup>st</sup> 1886 by the  
Board of Fire & Water Commissioners  
of the City of Marquette; being twenty-  
two bonds of Five Hundred Dollars  
(\$500.) each, bearing five per cent  
interest, commencing January 1<sup>st</sup> 1886.  
Ending January 1<sup>st</sup> 1896. Number  
of bonds from one to twenty-two  
inclusive.

These bonds were issued for  
the purpose of taking up old Bonds  
which became due November 15<sup>th</sup>  
1885, issue of 1875. Number of  
bonds: 1. 2. 3. 4. 5. 11. 12. 13. 14. 15 & 16.  
of one thousand dollars each, bearing  
seven per cent interest.

New Bonds (\$15,000)  
issued July 1<sup>st</sup> 1888. by the Board  
of Fire & Water Commissioners of the City  
of Marquette; being Thirty Bonds of  
Five hundred dollars each (\$500)  
bearing interest at five per cent per  
annum; payable semi-annually. Number  
one to Thirty-inclusive. Maturing July  
First 1898. Issued to take a like  
amount of Bonds, maturing July 1<sup>st</sup> 1888.
