The following report of the Board of Public Safety, submitted at its meeting on January 12, 1926, was read and approved by the Commission.

REPORT OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC SAFETY

The Board of Public Safety, organized on June 1, 1925, under the provisions of Ordinance No. 111, has the honor to report to you on its work during the year ending December 31, 1925. The Board has the pleasure to announce that during the year the number of crimes committed in the city of Marquette was 1,234, as against 1,345 in 1924. This represents a decrease of 8.2% in the number of crimes committed in the city during the year.

The Board has also the pleasure to announce that during the year the number of arrests made in the city of Marquette was 2,345, as against 2,156 in 1924. This represents an increase of 8.8% in the number of arrests made in the city during the year.

The Board has also the pleasure to announce that during the year the number of persons placed in the city jail was 1,234, as against 1,345 in 1924. This represents a decrease of 8.2% in the number of persons placed in the city jail during the year.

The Board has also the pleasure to announce that during the year the number of persons placed in the city hospital was 1,234, as against 1,345 in 1924. This represents a decrease of 8.2% in the number of persons placed in the city hospital during the year.
