This policy shall apply to all lump-sum construction and service contracts authorized by the County Board pursuant to its prevailing purchasing policy.

The County Administrator may authorize and execute amendments and change orders which adjust contract price and alter the scope of work during the term of an agreement as follows:

To meet unforeseen circumstances or, when necessary, to allow a project to proceed as intended, the Administrator may authorize changes which increase or decrease contract price by 5% of the original contract amount.

BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

At no time shall an amended contract price exceed the total amount appropriated, or likely to be appropriated, by the Board to accomplish the work or similar work.

The Administrator may direct a Department Head or Budgetary Unit Administrator to implement the provisions of this policy for a particular contract or category of work.

Clerk Roberts pointed out that the Resolution presented this evening has been drafted reflecting the four main issues that were voted on separately which all passed the Committee of the Whole. It would be very difficult to write separate recommendations for each of the issues.

It was moved by Comm. Seppanen, seconded by Comm. Arsenault and carried by voice vote 6 Ayes (Comm. Seppanen, Angeli, Arsenault, Cihak, Roberts, and Corkin) to 3 Nays (Comm. Bergdahl, Joseph, and Tuominen) that the County Board adopt the following Resolution Clarifying the Board of Health's Responsibilities:

RESOLUTION

<u>CLARIFICATION OF</u> BOARD OF HEALTH RESPONSIBILITIES

WHEREAS, under the Public Health Code P.A. 368 of 1978, MCLA 333.1101 et seq., the County may, but is not required to have a County Board of Health; and

WHEREAS, the Marquette County Board of Commissioners has elected to continue the Board of Health subject to the provisions of the Public Health Code; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners wishes to continue the rules and procedures which pertain to the appointment of the members of the Board of Health; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners wishes to clarify the role and responsibility of the Board of Health.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners hereby continues the Marquette County Board of Health subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The Board of Health shall consist of seven (7) members.
 - (a) One member shall be a doctor of medicine or doctor of osteopathy.
 - (b) Both sexes should be represented.
 - (c) One member shall be a member of the Marquette County Board of Commissioners.
- 2. The members of the Board of Health shall be appointed by the Marquette County Board of Commissioners pursuant to the Marquette County Appointments procedure.
- 3. The members of the Board of Health shall serve for three (3) years to be appointed in staggered terms in the same manner as members of other boards and commissions.
- 4. Members of the Board of Health may serve for consecutive terms so long as other qualifications for membership on the Board are met.
- 5. It is the duty of the Board of Health to represent the Board of Commissioners in all matters pertaining to the powers and duties of the Health Department as are conferred by law.
- 6. As required under the Public Health Code P.A. 368 of 1978, MCLA 333.2428 et seq., the Board of Commissioners shall select the Health Officer who must possess the qualifications established and approved by the State Health Department and who acts as the administrative officer of the Health Department.
- As required under the Public Health Code P.A. 368 of 1978, MCLA 333.2444 et seq., the Board of Commissioners shall
 adopt, revoke, increase, or amend fees for services performed by the Health Department.
- 8. As required under the Public Health Code P.A. 368 of 1978, MCLA 333.2441 et seq., all rules and regulations promulgated by the Board of Health (such as the Environmental Health Code and other Ordinances) are subject to review and approval or disapproval of a majority vote of the full Board of Commissioners.

- 9. As soon as practicable, after the close of the county fiscal year on December 31, the Board of Health shall require the Health Officer to make a written report to the Board of Health and Board of Commissioners of the work done by the Health Department during the last fiscal year. In addition, copies of Department monthly reports and minutes of monthly Board of Health meetings shall be provided to Commissioners as soon as they are available.
- The members of the Board of Health shall receive such compensation for their services as shall be determined by the Board of Commissioners.
- 11. Specific responsibilities delegated to the Board of Health, include but are not limited to:
 - (a) Assuring Health Department compliance with major policies established by the Board of Commissioners for county government as a whole, the Board of Health will assure that the Health Department generally follows the philosophy of the county employee classification/compensation system, however, the Board of Health may select a separate labor market for the Health Department subject to approval by the Board of Commissioners. The Health Officer is responsible for implementing Board of Commissioner policies within the Health Department.
 - (b) Representing the Board of Commissioners where county policy specifies Board of Commissioners action or review, except for those responsibilities specifically prescribed for the Board of Commissioners by the Michigan Public Health Code (i.e. items #6, #7, and #8 above).
 - (c) Establishment of additional major policies for the Health Department as long as these policies do not conflict with those established by the Board of Commissioners for county government as a whole. Proposed policies in a new area where county policy does not exist and which might reasonably be expected to affect the county as a whole must be approved by the County Board of Commissioners. The Health Officer is responsible for implementing Board of Health policies within the Department.
 - (d) Adoption of a balanced annual Health Department budget incorporating all revenue sources including the annual appropriation from the county. In order to create incentives to improve efficiency, increase year-end fund balances, and eventually achieve Department financial self-sufficiency, year end Health Department fund balances (if any) will be utilized in the following manner:
 - 1) Apply the first \$70,00 to the next year's General Fund annual appropriation to the Department.
 - Apply 40% of the amount over \$70,000 to a Health Department "Reserve Fund" which would be allowed to accumulate from year to year with interest.
 - Apply 60% of the amount over \$70,000 to the next year's General Fund annual county appropriation to the Department.
 - (e) Amendment of the annual budget, as necessary, provided such amendment does not require an additional county appropriation and provided the budget remains balanced. All amendments shall be immediately provided to the County Administrator and County Finance Manager after adoption by the Board of Health.
 - (f) Approval of all new Health Department positions unless the positions are grant funded and the Board of Health has already authorized the position(s) by approval of submission of the grant application in conformance with County Financial Policy 228 Grant Authorization/Appropriations. All vacant positions can be filled by the Health Department. The Health Department will be subject to county moratoriums on personnel (e.g., job freezes, layoffs, etc.) only if specifically included by the Board of Commissioners.
 - (g) Approval of contracts and contract amendments provided that such contracts do not involve real estate and provided that county-wide policies regarding purchasing and capital expenditures are adhered to.
 - (b) Overseeing the process of negotiating Health Department labor agreements within parameters consistent with the Bargaining Philosophy statement adopted by the Board of Commissioners. The Board of Health is responsible for approving negotiated labor agreements and amendments.
- 12. All resolutions previously adopted by the Board of Commissioners which are inconsistent with this resolution are hereby repealed.

Adopted this 21st day of August, 1997 Gerald O. Corkin, Chairperson Marquette County Board of Commissioners 10d) The County Board considered a recommendation from the Committee of the Whole that the EDA Grant be amended to have Marquette County be the sole point of contact and lead entity under the EDA Agreement, and further, that Ron Koshorek be responsible for grant administration, and also administration funds should be used to hire a project manager that would assist Ron Koshorek and Hal Pawley, Airport Manager. The EDC will continue to remain the lead entity for Building No. 664, and continue to prepare and justify the 1997 EDA Grant Application.

County Administrator Steve Powers also would like the County Board to add to the recommendation a waiver of the purchase policy up to \$20,000 for hiring a contractual grant administrator. This could be for a period of up 18 months with a review every three months. The contract with the EDA includes funding for administration.

Comm. Joseph noted that the EDC Board met and unanimously concurred with the Committee of the Whole Recommendation. The EDC Board says lets get the project done and not worry about the problems of the past and who was at fault.

Chairperson Corkin thanked the EDC for their cooperation.

It was moved by Comm. Roberts, seconded by Comm. Arsenault and unanimously carried by voice vote that the County Board approve the Committee of the Whole Recommendation to have Marquette County be the only entity under agreement with the EDA, Ron Koshorek will be responsible for grant administration, and that a waiver of the purchase policy be approved for up to \$20,000 for the hiring of a grant administrator.

- 10e) It was moved by Comm. Arsenault, seconded by Comm. Roberts and carried by voice vote 8 Ayes to 1 Nay (Comm. Cihak) that the County Board approve of the supplements to leases with the Air Force Base Conversion Authority, Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to Lease #BCA-KIS-12-97-0301 and Supplemental Agreement No. 4 to Lease #DA-20-064-ENG-1704.
- 10f) The County Board considered a Committee of the Whole Recommendation to approve and Employment Agreement with Ed Bailey, Operations Manager at the K.I. Sawyer Development Department.

Steve Powers, County Administrator, noted that in the draft of the contract presented by the Committee of the Whole the agreement effective date was listed as July 1, 1997. The effective date should be August 21, 1997 upon County Board approval this evening.

It was moved by Comm. Arsenault, seconded by Comm. Tuominen and unanimously carried by voice vote that an employment agreement with Ed Bailey, Operations Manager at the K.I. Sawyer Development Department be approved August 21, 1997.

LATE ADDITIONS

11a) The County Board considered Change Order No. 1 with Pentecost Construction for the Heating Conversion Projects (Group A1). Steve Powers, County Administrator, noted that this change order reduces the contract by \$40,188. This is being accomplished through a number of factors including: changing brands of boilers, changing from a forced air to an atmospheric system, and in some cases utilizing two small boilers with the same BTU output as one large boiler. This change order provides for savings of dollars at no decrease in the quality of work.

It was moved by Comm. Arsenault, seconded by Comm. Roberts and unanimously carried by voice vote that the County Board approve of Change Order No. 1 for the Heating Conversion (Group A1) with Pentecost Construction.

11b) The County Board considered the contract award for 10 buildings (Group A2) for the K.I. Sawyer Heating Conversion Project. The low bidder was Industrial Piping Co. of Marquette in the amount of \$512,000.

Ed Bailey, Operations Manager, KI Sawyer Development Department, was present and explained that the first 18 buildings will cost approximately \$1 million for heat conversion. Also, there are four AMR Buildings being converted at a cost of \$300,000, which brings 22 buildings costing \$1.3 million. There will be another 10 buildings (Group A3) contract awarded with an estimated cost of \$500,000, for a total of 32 buildings converted by the end of the year at a cost of \$1.8 million.

It was moved by Comm. Arsenault, seconded by Comm. Roberts and unanimously carried by voice vote that the County Board award the contract for furnishing, installing, and making operational alternative heating systems for 10 buildings (Group A2), at KI Sawyer to Industrial Piping Company of Marquette in the amount of \$512,000.

Chairperson Corkin opened the meeting for public comment. None was forthcoming.

COMMISSIONER COMMENTS, STAFF COMMENTS, AND ANNOUNCEMENTS

County Administrator Steve Powers reported on the aviation activity at KI Sawyer. The Airport will receive approximately \$500 to \$1,000 in landing fees. The activity is related to FAA requirements regarding altitude and will last for several more weeks.

Comm. Joseph reported on the Michigan Association of Counties Conference held at the Marquette Superior Dome, August 17 through 19. He is happy to report we received good comments from many Counties who were happy to make the trip to Marquette. All were pleasantly surprised. The tree decorations were excellent and well received.

Chairperson Corkin noted that this was the first MAC Conference held in the Upper Peninsula in 99 years. On behalf of Marquette County and the whole Upper Peninsula we demonstrated we could do anything and accommodate such a conference. The service provided by NMU was excellent, the meals were good, and all in all we did the Upper Peninsula and Marquette County proud. Chairperson Corkin thanked the whole Board for their support, especially Comm. Rapport, Angeli, and Cihak, and County Staff.

Chairperson Corkin attended the Mine Reclamation Hearing conducted by State Senator Koivisto on Wednesday, August 20th. He noted that about one year ago the County Board voted against legislation to rescind the Mine Reclamation Act and sent Civil Counsel Payant and Equalization Director Markey to Lansing to testify at a hearing. That has turned out to be a good decision by the County Board. Now there is strong support for Mine Reclamation. The hearing was well attended and much good dialog took place especially regarding properties with abandoned buildings, they should be the responsibility of the property owners and not left for the taxpayers in the future.

Comm. Seppanen noted that the City of Ishpeming had some strong comments in the media regarding the proposed mitigation plan by Cleveland-Cliffs to improve wetlands in Dickinson County. He noted that Earl Yelle, Sands Township Supervisor, suggested that Cleveland-Cliffs create wetlands in Sands Township. He wondered if County Staff had any alternative plans to suggest for the proposed mitigation. Commission consensus was that the mitigation should be as close to the area being effected, or at least in Marquette County.

Comm. Joseph suggested that the County Board send a letter to CCI requesting that they stay in Marquette County with their proposed mitigation of wetlands.

Comm. Cihak suggested that a copy of this letter be sent to all cities and townships in Marquette County so perhaps they too could express their concerns.

Comm. Tuominen suggested that the letter include an explanation as to why if mitigation cannot be done in Marquette County.

It was moved by Comm. Seppanen, seconded by Comm. Joseph and unanimously carried by voice vote that the County Board send a letter to Cleveland-Cliffs requesting that they restore wetlands nearby or at least somewhere in Marquette County and further, if this cannot be done please provide the information as to why it cannot.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:52 p.m.
