















Married Housing


Attend 3rd Consecutive NCAA Div. II Playoffs

Although the cold had long ago numbed their hands and feet, their senses were alive. Many of them felt the first sting of the realization they had lost.













MARCHING BAND BOASTS NEW LOOK







"This year's group is the best I've ever worked with," Michelson said, "in both musicianship and attitude." The key word for the band this year was "Pride".






First yess head coach Jane Scheper had eight returning letter winners on her 1977 roster, but only two of these players had more than one year of experience.




These disadvantages may be responsible for the teams 16 losses compared to 6 wins for the season.




NMU Women Roundballers: Set Improvement As Goal







Among those leading Northern were Seniors Zachary Hicks and Gary Hubka, two cagers who received honorable mention for All-Conference in the 1976-77 season.






Just a few among many graduating seniors are Merry Jo Starrine, Magers Hall resident director, and honor student Robert J. Buchkoe (magna cum laude).


