

SPECIAL MEETING

December 18, 1969

Present at this special meeting were David Meneghel (Chairman), Robert McClellan, John Watanen, Theodore Davenport, John P. Farrell, William Farley, Phillip May and Jarl Roine; excused was Donald Baker.

Vice Chairman McClellan presented the Executive Committee the chronology of events of December 17 as they pertained to the sit-in in the Student Personnel Offices. (This chronology is to be distributed to the membership of the Faculty Organization in a different statement.)

After discussion which centered around such considerations as the damage done to the Student Personnel Offices, and alleged threats made to Vice President Niemi, it was moved (May, Farley) that the proposed resolution supporting President Jamrich's handling of the sit-in be submitted to The Academic Senate; the motion carried unanimously. The press release written by McClellan, Meneghel, and Watanen was also approved by the Executive Committee. (See attached copy.)
