

Memorandum for the Files
February 12, 1970

Approximately at 10:00 on February 12 I had a call from Dave Warner of our Art department telling me that "Pat Williams had just come in to see him and that he had just spent all night in jail because he was unable to pay a parking ticket for which he was picked up last night by the police." The parking ticket had been issued during the campus break while Pat Williams was presumably loading trunks into his car.

I then called Mr. Lyons of our Security Division who told me that Pat Williams had not spent the night in jail, that he and four other students (white) had been picked up on a warrant last night for failure to respond to a summons on parking tickets, and that Pat Williams, after discussion in the police station for about forty minutes, had posted ten dollars bond and was released.
