This is with reference to your memorandum dated February 17, 1970 in which you recommend that, unless significant new evidence can be brought before you, the cases of the five students named in your memorandum be dropped.

I have discussed this matter with members of the staff and am informing you that I concur in your recommendation. Your recommendation and my concurrence is being forwarded to the Office of the Dean of Students who will notify the five students of the disposition of the case.

Your farther recommendation, that the procedures of the Judiciary be refined, is immediately being presented for consideration to the Task Force Implementation Committee with the understanding that an appropriate working committee undertake the full consideration of the Student Code of Conduct.
