Re: Environmental and Educational Conditions Present at Northern

We, the Black Students of Northern, feel that the conditions which exist here at this university are not conducive to our educational goals in which we set out to obtain.

In regard to this we are submitting the following demands:

1. 4% increase in Black enrollment by September '70, 6% by September '71, and 11% increase by September '72.
2. Guaranteed 11% increase in Black Faculty.
3. Black studies program on a four point program with Black instructors.
4. Black literature in Library.
5. Extension and increasement of Black Aides Program.
6. Cancellation of Teach-In, May 19, 1970.
7. Appropriate \$5,000 dollars for cultural events per/yr.
