Dear Mr. Thibodeau:

This will confirm our second telephone conversation today and especially the one of today with some emphasis on the fact that obvious activity and pressures are building up on the campus and my request for some additional manpower to at least provide a preventative surveillance of the campus periphery.

I realize fully that there are limitations on manpower in the State Police Offices. I have been in contact with the City Police, and they have been cooperative but in general have maintained that the majority of their manpower should be reserved for larger action than what we are talking about.

My simple request is that, first of all, utilizing our present campus security as fully as we can, we do have additional manpower available during the night especially in a nearby, near-campus capacity to help us in some preventative measures.

Your cooperation in this matter will be very much appreciated.
