**MEMORANDUM**

**Date:** May 15, 1970

The following recommendation was made and unanimously approved at the May 15, 1970 meeting of the Human Rights Commission:

"That any Black student who feels he is in danger be allowed to leave without penalty. "Without penalty" means they may take the grade they now have or take an "I" and do the work necessary to make up the "I" at home and mail it back to Northern."
