Dear President Jamrich:

As you know, faculty members have been spending evenings in the dormitories between 7:00 p.m. and 3:00 a.m. for the last couple of nights in an attempt to cool whatever student tension we may have. About sixty faculty members have been involved in these visitations. Mr. Stevens and I have visited with almost all of these people on both Saturday and Sunday nights and their attitude as they have discussed it with us is that the tensions reported in various meetings on the campus have been blown out of all proportion. The facts are, on the basis of the discussions with the students, that the Blacks do have a problem on this campus which is a result not of anything unique to Northern Michigan University, but to the problems in society at large. I think it is the consensus of this faculty group based upon the conversations with our student body that it would be useless to close the institution at this time. They also feel, I think, that the Black students are not, in fact, in any physical danger.

Attached is a list of the faculty who have so far participated in the visitations in the dormitory areas on Saturday and Sunday, May 16 and 17.
