This is to express my deepest concern and distress at the possible detrimental effect on Northern Michigan University if on the basis of no facts and the distortion of facts we permit the road show approach to continuing investigations of the campus situation. As of this date everything continues to be calm and normal with business as usual.

The idea of an Attorney General's investigation, a hearing by the Colleges and Universities Committee of the House, and a visit by another group from the Michigan Civil Rights Commission with an assistant to the Attorney General adds nothing but can contribute to the development of a very undesirable situation and be most detrimental to a fine state university.

Your consideration of this concern which I am expressing for myself and on behalf of the Board of Control will be appreciated.
