The Charles Griffis tapes were made available to the Student-Faculty Judiciary for the appeal. After the appeal, they were erased which is in keeping with the established policy that tapes of closed hearings are made available only for an appeal and for no other purpose.

The tapes of the Student-Faculty Judiciary hearing are available. That was an open hearing.
