Dear Mr. Griffis:

As I am sure you are aware, the Student-Faculty Judiciary acted upon your request for an appeal and decided to grant you a new hearing, which took place on the evening of December 17 to the morning of December 18.

As a result of that new hearing, it is the decision of the Student-Faculty Judiciary that the appropriate action to be taken at this time is a decision of "not guilty" due to insufficient evidence.

It should be noted that the Student-Faculty Judiciary evaluated every possible aspect of this case including (1) the Human Rights Committee report to the President; (2) the tape recorded record from the All-University Student Judiciary; (3) the testimony of all witnesses; and (4) your's and your council's statements, in reaching this decision.

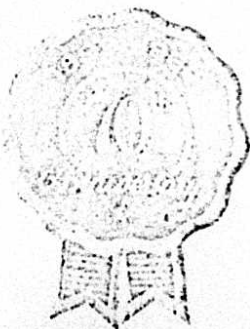
